Brief description of task	<p>Covid-19 is a new illness that can affect your lungs and airways. It is caused by a virus called Coronavirus. Symptoms can be mild, moderate, severe or fatal.</p> <p>This assessment covers all Murfitts workers (factory and office) and all subcontractors.</p>

Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<p><u>Hand Washing</u></p> <p>Hand washing facilities with soap and water in place. Drying of hands with disposable paper towels. Staff encouraged to protect the skin by applying emollient cream regularly (workshop technicians). Gel sanitisers in any area where washing facilities not readily available.</p> <p><u>Cleaning</u></p> <p>Frequently cleaning and disinfecting objects and surfaces that are touched regularly particularly in areas of high use such as door handles, light switches, control panels, machinery, tools, canteen</p>		<p>Employees to be reminded on a regular basis (by posters displays and supervisors and managers) to wash their hands for 20 seconds with water and soap and the importance of proper drying with disposable towels. Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it, Bin it, Kill it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands. Tissues will be made available throughout the workplace.</p> <p>Rigorous checks will be carried out by line managers to ensure that the necessary procedures are being followed.</p>
